### Praise, rewards & achievements.

Parents often ask about the rewards that children receive in school (and we know that many children are not very communicative when they return from school!) so here is an overview of how children are recognised and praised for a wide variety of things when in school.



**House points:** These are awarded by ALL staff to pupils on an individual basis but they contribute towards each child's allocated house. Weekly totals are shared in assembly and added to the grand total for each house. The winning house at the end of the year participate in a celebratory event together.

**Golden Acorns:** These are rewards given to whole classes when they have demonstrated specific behaviours or attitudes that have been decided between the class teacher and pupils collaboratively.

**Twitter:** Individuals, groups and classes are praised via this social media platform so that the whole community can share in their success.

**Postcards home:** These are sent home by Mrs Shirley and Miss Beeston for pupils who have gone 'above and beyond' in terms of expectation, maturity, attitude, exemplary behaviour or significant improvement.

**Worker of the week:** Class teachers select one pupil whose achievements over the week have demonstrated and exemplified our school values.

**Outside achievements:** We recognise, celebrate and share any achievements that pupils receive for activities they participate in outside school like sports, brownies/guides/scouts or other personal pursuits.

**Golden table:** Awarded to those who have demonstrated excellent manners, polite voices, positive attitudes to trying new foods and 'restaurant behaviour' in the dining hall.

**Attendance:** As well as celebrating full attendance at the end of every term and the end of the year, we take a look at this weekly and reward classes who have attained 100% attendance over the week a gift certificate for £5 for them to spend as they please.
