Literacy & Phonics

In Nursery and Reception we follow the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Phonics Programme. The Wrens will be focusing on lots of speaking and listening activities in phonics to help them discriminate between and tune into different sounds.

The Robins will start Phase 2 in Phonics and will learn 4 new sounds a week and will be learning how to blend to read words with sounds that they already know. Your child will come home with a 'sound book' and each week our new sounds will be added so that you can continue to support your child at home.

In Literacy we will be focusing on the traditional story 'The Three Little Pigs', non-fiction writing linked to the text and Bonfire poems. We will also be sharing lots of other exciting texts daily to introduce the children to different genres, new vocabulary and to instil a love of reading.

The Wrens and Robins will bring home a library book each week and the Robins will bring home a decodable book in addition. Watch this space for a parental workshop to help you support your child at home with these areas.

Topic

Our topic this half-term is 'All About Me'. We will be focusing on family and pets, homes and healthy me.
