

- During this meeting the class will discuss the day's learning, how they have got on, any problems and prepare for the next day with an adult leading the discussion.

Lessons and what/where to record work

- Lessons on your child's timetable will be presented in different ways. There will be instructions included about what your child should write down or 'do' and where he/she should record it – it may be an online recording form or into their exercise book.
- You may be asked to upload a photo of the work to Seesaw or Teams for the child's teacher to assess and/or give feedback

Marking and Feedback

An integral part of learning is the marking and feedback given to each child. This will happen in a range of different ways including some or all of the following:

- Marking work as part of the lesson
- Individual marking and feedback typed onto Seesaw or MS Teams
- Class feedback during the daily recorded message (younger pupils) or the live Teams meeting (for older pupils)
- Individual telephone conversations

You have been extremely patient and understanding so far as we have needed to interpret guidance, gather information, make plans and organise a LOT of things in preparation for tomorrow onwards – THANK YOU from all of us. We have felt very supported and it has been a pleasure making phone calls to each one of our families to find out how you are and what your needs are in the coming weeks.
